- Transborder cultural trail "Borderland Atlantis" (more information: www.borderlandatlantis.net/);

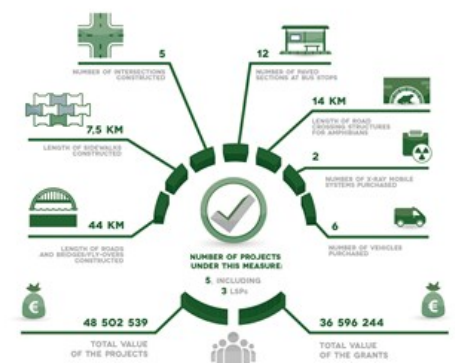


- Historical Museum in Neringa;

LT-PL-RU PROGRAMME "IN BIG NUMBERS" - MEASURE 1.2

We would like to present next section of our story of the Programme results. In this issue we are providing information on the projects implemented within Measure 1.2. Accessibility improvement. They were aimed at improving road quality and safety as well as border crossing infrastructure. The identified need for improving the passenger and cargo transport network in the region was addressed by the projects implemented under this measure. Priority was given to development of the existing road infrastructure leading to border crossing points (eg. modernisation of roads, construction of bridges, etc). Also border crossing facilities were improved (eg. new mobile X-ray systems for border and customs control were installed). This contributed to reducing border wait times and combating smuggling.

NEXT STEP IN PREPARATION OF THE NEW PROGRAMME POLAND-RUSSIA 2014-2020

We would like to inform you that we have just finished the public hearings of two documents: the draft Joint Operational Programme (JOP) for the Poland-Russia Cross-Border Cooperation Programme 2014-2020 (10 June 2016) and the Environmental Assessment Report of the new Programme (5 June 2016).
